We are developing AI-powered health screening, atmospheric water generation, and community laundry infrastructure for remote Aboriginal communities — because every community deserves access to essential services, regardless of location.

Remote Aboriginal communities are being denied the window of early detection — the 5–10 silent years when most chronic diseases can be detected and treated simply and cheaply. The solution is not more flying doctors or longer waiting lists. It is bringing portable, AI-powered screening directly to Country, combined with the foundational infrastructure of clean water and

basic hygiene.

OUR SERVICES

Three Pillars of Community Wellbeing

AI Health Screening

- Cardiac — portable ECG + AI + cardiologist
- Eye — retinal imaging, diabetic retinopathy
- Vital signs — contactless 60-second scan
- Cervical cancer — AI image analysis
- Breast — radiation-free thermal imaging

All 5 screenings under 5 min each. No travel required.

Community Laundries

- Commercial-grade washing with medicative detergents
- Targets scabies, RHD and skin infections
- 5+ local jobs per site, 38hrs/week
- KPMG: \$6 healthcare savings per \$1 invested
- Off-grid solar + water recycling capable

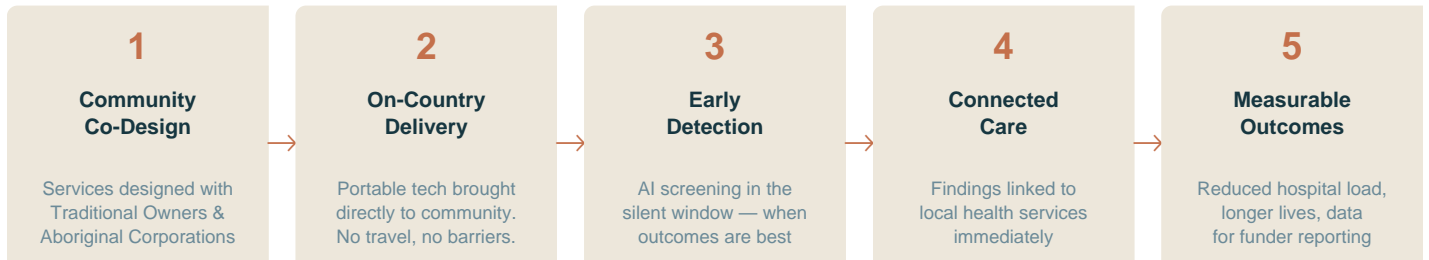
Water Solutions

- Atmospheric water generation (AWG)
- Extracts clean water directly from air
- Solar-powered, fully off-grid
- No bore or mains connection required
- Integrated with laundry infrastructure

Removes water access as a barrier to service delivery.
